Following our week there, we will experience a working vacation around the Great Lakes, ministering in three churches in Michigan and New York and taking in various sites along the way.

### Meanwhile in England

Membership at Faith Baptist in Lakenheath has grown to 50. There were 108 visitors in June, seven of those first-time visitors. Their faithfulness on visitation is to be commended once again: 23 were out on Saturation Saturday on 13 July, and as God frequently does, He saved a soul the next day after service! Two babies have been born to our dear families there as well. Children are an heritage of the Lord!

We desire to make a trip to see our church family prior to going there permanently. It appears that God may be keeping our schedule open in December for this very purpose. We will be seeking the Lord's will in the matter, and may have an opportunity where you could give to help us get there.
