Since the last letter ...

We have two new churches that have voted to support us, one is pending for next week, and two more churches where we presented in the fall should begin sending support this month (and are not counted in our total support yet). We're officially at 71% support with several good prospects to take us on for support.

Up next

This letter comes out a bit early, since I will be away from home most of the next month (and when I'd normally issue the letter). One or both of us will be in meetings in Utah, Colorado, Indiana, Michigan, North Carolina, and Georgia before our next prayer letter comes out. We're praying for God's hand on those services and for us to have the ability to minister both inside and outside of church walls in the places God has sent us.

In England

At the moment, Faith Baptist Church of Lakenheath is able to meet in person even though most nonreligious activities are curtailed due to coronavirus. Several new families have joined, although in a short time we will be losing one core family that goes back to the church's founding in 2017. That's military ministry: you can have 100% turnover in church membership in three years and none was due to getting mad at the pastor!
